## TOWN OF ANDERSON ORDINANCE REGULATING THE APPROVAL OF TOWN ROADS FOR ATV/UTV USAGE ORDINANCE # 11-13-2018

ORDINANCE # <u>11-13-2018</u>
The legal governing body of the Town of Anderson, Burnett County, Wisconsin, meeting in regular session on thisday of, 2018 does ordain the following:
INTENT  The purpose of this ordinance is to establish all-terrain vehicle and utility terrain vehicle routes in the Town of Anderson and to regulate the operation of all-terrain and utility terrain vehicles within the town.
STATUTORY AUTHORITY  The Town Board of Anderson, Burnett County, Wisconsin has the specific authority to adopt this all-terrain and utility terrain vehicle route ordinance under Wisconsin Statutes 23.33(8)(b) and (11).
ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE The Town Board of Anderson, Burnett County, Wisconsin, by this ordinance, adopted on proper notice with a quorum and unanimous vote by the town board provides the authority for the Town to designate all-terrain vehicle routes in the Town and to regulate the use of those routes for all-terrain and utility terrain vehicles in the Town.
OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN AND UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLES  All paved Town roads are designated all-terrain and utility terrain vehicle routes in the Town unless specifically signed for no ATV/UTV. All unpaved roads are non-designated in Town of Anderson.
<ul> <li>Pursuant to s.23.33(4)(d)4, Wis Stats, no person operates all-terrain or utility terrain vehicles on the roadway portion of any highway in the Town of Anderson except on roadways that are designated routes by this ordinance.</li> <li>All operators shall ride single file on the right side of the road.</li> <li>All operators shall observe the posted 25 mph speed limit.</li> <li>All operators shall slow the vehicle to 10 mph or less when operating within 150 feet of a dwelling or 100 feet of a pedestrian, cyclist or equestrian.</li> <li>All persons born on or after January 1, 1988 must be certified in ATV safety education when operating an all-terrain or utility terrain vehicle per Wis Statute 23.33(5).</li> <li>Children under 16 must be accompanied by an 18 or older adult.</li> <li>All operators and passengers under age 18 are required to wear a helmet.</li> <li>Owners of the ATV/UTV shall be responsible for the safe operation of their machine whether they are on them or not.</li> <li>Routes must be signed in accordance with Statute 23.33 NR 64.12 and NR 64.12(7)c</li> </ul>
ENFORCEMENT This ordinance may be enforce by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of the State of Wisconsin.
PENALTIES  Wisconsin State all-terrain or utility terrain vehicle penalties under Statute 23.33 (13)(a), Wis Statutes./are adopted by reference.
This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication or posted as provided by Wis. Stats. Dec. 11, 2018.  Passed on
