- 6. Treasurer's Report**

We have \$2,657.33 in checking and \$89,775.89 in the money market. For total assets of \$92,433.22.

7. Fire Association Report

There were 13 runs year to date last year and we are at 16 run so for this year. It has been a discussion of the townships use of equipment at incidents. The towns of Anderson and Woodriver will not use their equipment except to plow roads as needed.

8. Chairman's Report

We need to officially close heritage Road. We will be working the county and Josh from MSA, to get a new scope and to see what is closed. Would like to have this done by the end of Summer. Will keep on the agenda to present updates

9. Planning Commission

Jeremy Gronski is going to talk to G. Conroy about water samples. We have some volunteers for this already. We will also work with the county and other towns on the rural water association. Jim Ulmaniec will talk with the Friends of Crex about partnering with them. We are still looking into the possibility of talking with landowners about changing zoning. However, we do not have any farms big enough to meet the CAFO guidelines.

10. Clerks Information

After some discussion we will be participating in the beaver damage management program this year. The cost is \$1,950. Jim Bethke feels that he could do it for less but Jeremy Gronski and Tim Harmon feel this could take a lot of his time away from his work. We will re-evaluated it next year.

We will have a special closed session to discuss salary for Carmen Bouchie's help and for the town clerk.

We have decided to have the Annual meeting on April 20, 2021 and to have the BBQ this year. Will have the annual report booklet ready to print by March 26th so we can have it to had out at the April 6th election. Those that did not pick up their books, will be

mailed. Jeremy Gronski said he would take the food prep and Patsy will make some desserts.

11. Forestry Report

Jim Ulmaniec presented three contracts for tree planting. It was decided that Superior Forestry Service, Inc was the best value. Jeremy Gronski motioned to award the contract to Superior Forestry Service, Inc. Tim Harmon seconded. Motion carried.

12. Capital Plan

We have 4 bids for the land. It will need to be re-zoned the first offers were rejected. Len Chute has communicated this to them.

13. Road Maintenance Report/Projects for the Month

Jim Bethke said that the county is talking about crushing gravel every other year. We have projects that we will need gravel for. This means that we may need to increase what we're are spending this year to cover next year if they won't be crushing.

The mower deck is almost done, and the shop lights are completed.
