**Treasurer's Report**

Patsy Tucker gave the Treasurer's report. As of October 31, 2021 we had \$10,655.84 in checking and \$281,744.18 in the money market for a total of \$292,400.02. Patsy also updated the September 2021 report to reflect a check that was void.

**Approving levy**

Motion was made by Jeremy Gronski to approve a town levy of \$108,122. Tim Harmon seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**Adoption of the 2022 annual budget**

Tim Harmon motioned to approve the Town of Anderson 2022 annual budget of \$538,970.41. Jim Loomis seconded the motion. Motion carried.
