REM Inspecting report

Nikki from REM Inspecting gave the 2025 update. The Town of Anderson was issued 5 new dwelling permits. REM has moved to a "One Drive" system. Nikki will send Annette Bethke access to the drive. This is where all the history is kept for the town.

Nikki explained that as of now the town only is requiring permits for new dwellings. The Town can change this to add accessory building if they choose to.

Treasurer's Report

Patsy Tucker gave the Treasurer's report. The Town of Anderson has \$2,658.82 in checking, a total of \$247,632.68 in money market funds and \$28,553.90 in the machinery fund. This for total assets of \$278,845.40. This reconciles with all bank statements.

Kevin Louis gave the Fire Association report. They are getting a bid for a SCVA compressor to recharge their air tanks. This could be between \$27,000-\$45,000. The new fire inspector started March 17, 2026.

Jim is looking at having 4 miles of roads chip sealed this year. It will be about \$24,000 a mile. This will help our blacktop roads last longer.
