

**Town of Anderson**  
**Meeting minutes**  
**Annual Meeting per Sec 60.11 (1)(2)**  
**April 21, 2026 at Town Hall at 6:45 PM**

James Mielke called the meeting to order. He introduced each of the Board members, Patsy Tucker, the Town Treasurer and Annette Bethke, the Town clerk.

James Meilke led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Approval of minutes of the 2025 annual meeting minutes**

Kevin Louis motioned to approve the 2025 meeting minutes as written. Paul Baxter seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**Open the floor to electors**

James Meilke opened the floor up to the electors.

Paul Baxter asked about the leaking overhang on the Town Hall. James Mielke explained that this was in the process of being fixed in the next week or so.

Paul then asked about the bridge on Carl Berg Road and what was being done to get it fixed. It was explained that Jim Bethke had spoken with the County and had the bridge inspected. The bridge itself was in good condition. The issue is that land is being washed away under the bridge. Jim is working with the County to get this fixed.

The Equipment Fund was brought up by Paul Baxter, and he was wondering how money was being contributed to it. Annett Bethke explained that when a piece of equipment is sold the money goes into the equipment. Also, money is budgeted each year to go into the fund as well.

Calvin McQuay wants to know what can be done about barking dogs. His neighbor's dogs bark all day long and it is very disruptive to him and his family. Paul Baxter said he can hear them as well. Calvin said he has talked to his neighbors and the police several times and they have not done anything. James Mielke said that he has called the county and will try calling them again.

Ben Rengo asked about water testing. The Board said that there hasn't been any plan to have it done again but if people were interested in having it done again it would be considered.

Romana Moody said that the Comprehensive Plan had been discussed at the last Annual Meeting and was wondering if a committee has been formed. James Mielke said that he had a few people that would like to be on the committee, but no one wanted to take the lead. Two more people are still needed as well as a leader. The Board is still working on this.

Kevin Louis is the Fire Association liaison for the Town of Anderson. He said that right now we are negotiations for an Ambulance contract. They are trying to have 3 ambulances. If anyone has any questions, please contact the fire department. The next contract meeting is June 17.
